ORDER OF TEMPORARY SUSPENSION

The Office of the Disciplinary Administrator (ODA) moves the court to temporarily suspend Respondent DeVoe G. Treadwell's license to practice law in Kansas under Supreme Court Rule 213(a) (2023 Kan. S. Ct. R. at 266). Treadwell failed to timely respond as required under Rule 213(c). The court finds good cause for the temporary suspension based on the ODA's showing that Treadwell's disappearance and apparent abandonment of his law practice poses a substantial threat of harm to clients, the public, and the administration of justice.

Accordingly, the court grants the ODA's motion and temporarily suspends Treadwell's license to practice law until final disposition of the disciplinary proceeding or until further order of the court. Treadwell must timely comply with Supreme Court Rule 231 (2023 Kan. S. Ct. R. at 292).
