ANDERSON and CRISTY L. ANDERSON are further authorized to access the attorney's trust account and to take any action deemed to be necessary to protect the interests of the clients.

BRENT I. ANDERSON and CRISTY L. ANDERSON are authorized to delegate various legal duties to other attorneys with the approval of the client and/or the court. Pursuant to Rule 235(b) (2022 Kan. S. Ct. R. 308), the attorneys shall not disclose any information contained in the client files except as necessary to carry out the order of the court.
